Code of Conduct for Park Ridge Soccer**

Soccer is a game; it should be fun. Children play soccer to improve their skills, for excitement, to be with friends, to make new friends and to be part of a team. In your role as a soccer parent you have duties and responsibilities. You are responsible to help your player understand the meaning of success. Winning is not everything. Improving skills, both personally and as a team, giving maximum effort and striving to do one's best are all measures of success.

As a soccer parent, I am responsible for my own behavior and the behavior of my players. Under no circumstances will I participate in the following behaviors or allow my players to do so:

1. Blame a loss on a player, referee, parent or spectator.
2. Belittle or demean a player, referee, parent or spectator.
3. Curse or swear at a player, referee, parent or spectator.
4. Push or strike a player, referee, parent or spectator.

PRSA supplies reversible JERSEYS and two different colored pairs of SOCKS. These uniforms are intended to last for 2 years (4 soccer seasons). New JERSEYS and SOCKS will be provided at NO ADDITIONAL COST to participants EVERY 2 YEARS. If your player needs a REPLACEMENT jersey or ADDITIONAL socks in LESS than 2 years, you must pay an ADDITIONAL FEE. For new players in the Fall '10 season, a reversible jersey and 2 pair of socks are included in the standard fee.

As always, players must provide their own SHIN GUARDS, BLACK SHORTS and a BALL FOR PRACTICE. All players must wear black soccer shorts. Cleated soccer shoes are optional in the House League Program, but are NOT ALLOWED in the Instructional Program.
