### Instructional Program

Kindergarten coed program with children placed on teams by school whenever possible. A number of teams will be drawn from more than one school. Teams play every Saturday morning for hour long games, at 8:30 am, 9:30 am, or 10:30 am, on a variable schedule.

### House League Program

**1<sup>st</sup> graders - AGAIN THIS SEASON - 1<sup>st</sup> grade boys and girls will be on separate teams. Boys will play on Saturday mornings and Girls will play on Sunday afternoons.** 8-game season and teams setup by school whenever possible. A number of teams will be drawn from more than one school.

**2<sup>nd</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders** play an 8-game season with separate leagues for boys and girls. **Boys will play on Saturday mornings and Girls will play on Sunday afternoons.** Teams are set up according to player ratings from the previous season.

### Again This Season for Entire Program - High Quality, Multi-Season, Reversible Jerseys

PRSA supplies reversible JERSEYS and two different colored pairs of SOCKS. These uniforms are intended to last for 2 years (4 soccer seasons). New JERSEYS and SOCKS will be provided at NO ADDITIONAL COST to participants EVERY 2 YEARS. If your player needs a REPLACEMENT jersey or ADDITIONAL socks in LESS than 2 years, you must pay an ADDITIONAL FEE. For new players in the Spring 2010 season, a reversible jersey and 2 pair of socks are included in the standard fee.

As always, players must provide their own SHIN GUARDS, BLACK SHORTS, and a BALL FOR PRACTICE. All players must wear black soccer shorts. Cleated soccer shoes are optional in the House League Program, but are NOT ALLOWED in the Instructional Program.
